From the deep core of my heart, I extend thanks and appreciation for your unconditional support to us as a family and to my ministry which seeks to cater to “the least” of God’s children in Liberia.

I am a Congolese national serving in Liberia, West Africa. Along with my family, I came to Liberia in June 2000 as a General Board of Global Ministries (GBGM) sponsored Missioner of Hope. I served in this role for five years in various aspects of Children Ministry (street children, Literacy and Numeracy, tutorial and many other activities, etc.). In May 2007 I was commissioned as a GBGM Standard Support Missionary serving in Liberia as Director of the Department of Children’s Ministries.

I was commissioned on the Day of Pentecost in a Liberian Refugee Camp in Ghana. The location of my commissioning had a great impact on the nature of my work. My ministry is to Ex-combatant children (Child Soldiers), Internally Displaced children, girls abused by fighters, teen mothers and drop out victims of injustice. All of these populations were also in that Refugee Camp where I was commissioned. It is a risk-taking ministry..... but I am propelled by the significance of Pentecost - “anointed with the Holy Spirit to carry on fearlessly the ministry of human dignity restoration, healing, empowerment and a future of Hope, prosperity” Jeremiah 11:29.

I feel blessed and remain grateful of being connected with you in this partnership.

IN PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES

1. **Brighter Future Children Rescue Center in Buchanan (Grand Bassa County):** a Ministry to Ex-combatant children, Destitute Children, Street Kids, impoverished children in difficult circumstances...
2. **My Daughters’ Place Program in Tubmanville at Camphor Mission (Grand Bassa County):** a Ministry to Teen mothers, dropped out and villagers victims of injustice...
3. **Children Empowered for Sustainability Program in Kakata (Margibi County):** a Ministry to Girls perpetrators of abuse and those abused by Fighters and have turned to prostitution;
4. **Feed My Lamb Program in Pipe Line Community (Montserrado County):** a Ministry to Internally Displaced children, Street, Orphans and Abandoned Children...

I am conducting psycho social counseling and carry on different teachings to Ex-combatant children and youth; administrate day to day tasks / activities; Projects Management...

To acquaint you with the numerous achievements, challenges, prospects and needs in different projects - programs as mentioned above, I am enclosing flyers giving details on each of them.

Challenges are huge, but, with your prayers I will overcome. IT IS AN OPPORTUNITY TO PARTNER IN MINISTRY; touch a destitute child and make a difference.
