Marketers in the red lights area use them to sell plastic bags, water and cool or any other article they feel could generate funds for them ...in exchange of a little plate of food or not at all; (exploitation).

B. Children social backgrounds

The dissolved camp has poured on the streets many children who came from rural areas running away from the war;

Selling plastics, water, peanuts, coco nuts in exchange of a loaf of bread or nothing is the main activities as stated supra;

Other become pick pocketers;

Most of time they are half naked with the exposure to high risk diseases because Parents are jobless, in despair and Mothers struggle mostly to cater to the family needs;

Schooling and clothing are not a priority

They are in need of Love and NUTURE and later on an EMPOWERMENT

C. Programs and Activities

I provided a heavy two days in four days of learning sessions;

Free educational materials for learning and clothing to help look decent;

An elaborated Literacy program is given to the Kids without any charge;

An Advanced Class for tutorial activities, teachings on children rights and personal hygien

Sport activities for physical fitness; some exercises aimed to fighting the stress; devotion and literary program; and story telling...

Thinking of a scholarship program to help the Kids go back to school.
